- In the fall of 2018, the community came together to raise a pavilion at Rhinoceros Creek Reservation. This spring, we are adding a stone patio and native landscaping. It is certain to become the heart of Somers' newest green space.
- We are also continuing to offer nature-based programs to families and children through our partnership with The Rewilding School.
- And – most exciting of all for some of us – we have begun fundraising to purchase and install a composting toilet so you don't have to cut your adventures short.

Angle Fly Preserve In 2020 as we have since its opening in 2007, the Somers Land Trust will steward the preserve including its 10-mile trail system. We will offer season of The Rewilding School programs, and plan a host of scout projects. HVAC systems and other structural finishes should be installed in the Reynolds House by the end of the year.
